WAIT

- Waiting is not proactive. It is being idle and extremely unfulfilling. It is not the way the Lord intended for us to organize our family units and raise children unto Him.

W- “What If”

- As we wait we stay in a constant state of “what if.” We never do anything we want, put off plans, and sit by the phone waiting for that important call.

A- Anxious

- As we wait we get restless and are uneasy. We feel a lot of anxiety and worry about things we have no control over.

I- Insecure

- As we wait we feel insecure and doubt our capacity to parent. We feel unworthy and have a sense of low self-worth.

T- Tense

- As we wait the tension is high. We feel high amounts of stress and pressure. If we are not careful contention can easily enter the home and we begin to blame and hurt each other's feelings easily.

FIND

- Finding is active. It is being proactive in the search for your child. It is following the principle of doing all that we can and then relying on the Lord to put it all in place. Actively searching for your child builds the spiritual bonds of love and charity between you and God and the child you will be bringing into your home. It is a Labor of Love.

F- Faith

- It takes faith to search for that missing child that should be in your home. Faith in prayer, that Heavenly Father will guide you and place you in the right places. Faith through fasting, that you will encounter that birthmother carrying your child. Faith in everything we do, turning over our agency to God, knowing that He will direct our path and find our children.

I- Inspiration

- Following the Spirit as he inspires us to talk with those around us about our missing child. Listening to the promptings and living close to the spirit to direct our efforts in the right directions.

N- Networking

- To find your child it is important to talk to everyone. Use every possible channel to get the word out. Enlist the help of others to find that child. As you expand your voice through others the likelihood of finding the child increases.

D- Divine Intervention

- Once you have done all that you can, you can rely on the Lord to intervene in your behalf. It is only through Him that all things are possible. Allow Him to work the miracles. Allow Him to take away your pain and worry. Allow Him to bring peace to your heart because He will direct the way you bring your child home.
